ACCOMMODATION

Bedrooms and bathrooms

The six guest bedrooms are located on two sides of the villa. On one side the master bedroom with a four-poster bed, a study with a fireplace and a private marble bathroom with a shower and a bath; a double room with bathroom and shower, a double Suite with living area and bathroom with ensuite shower located at pool level. a double bedroom with ensuite shower room, a Family Suite with a double and a double and two private bathrooms with a terrace (the suite can be transformed into 2 separate and independent bedrooms).
