LOCAL AREA

Villa Belle Epoque is in the heart of Cannes, with all its delights, including restaurants, bars, shops, clubs and beaches within easy reach. A walk along the city promenade in Cannes, La Croisette (10 minutes' walk), is a must as you soak up the glitz and glamour that surrounds you. The fashionable city has a brilliant nightlife, some superb restaurants and a great choice of lovely sandy beaches, both public and private.

It will be hard to miss the Palais des Festivals, the home of the Cannes Festival, where you can see the stars' handprints in the famous 'Allee des Stars'. However, if you want to learn more about what Cannes was like as a fishing village in the time before the festival, head to the narrow labyrinth of lanes in Le Suquet, where the fishermen and their families used to live. Nowadays it has a magical atmosphere with pretty restaurants, bars and shops for visitors to enjoy.

If you want to find a more natural retreat, just take a ferry across to the beautiful Îles de Lérins, two pretty islands where you can take a picnic and find a rocky cove backed by pine and eucalyptus trees. Further afield, there is the medieval hilltop town of Mougins (7km), historic Grasse (18km) and the beautiful city of Nice (34km).
